Greetings and wishing you good health, thank you for choosing Karmania Hospital as your treatment center.

In order to inform you, we draw your attention to matters regarding admission and how to calculate hospitalization fees.

- Locuments required for admission:
- ✓ Hospitalization order of the attending physician
- ✓ Valid ID card
- ✓ Valid insurance booklet (for clients who have insurance coverage.)
- ✓ Letter of introduction from supplementary insurance (regarding clients who have supplementary insurance.)
- Receipt of payment as a deposit (the amount is on account and varies according to the type of service provided.)
- How to calculate hospitalization costs:
- ✓ Surgical fee: It is calculated based on a coefficient called K surgery and is selected from the California book that is valid throughout the country. The K value of surgery is different according to the type of surgery. For example, for a caesarean section, K surgery is 40. K * 1011000
- ✓ Anesthesia fee: It is calculated based on a coefficient called anesthesia K. The amount of anesthesia is calculated according to the time, the basis of anesthesia and based on the California book, which is valid throughout the country.
 - K * 1011000
- ✓ Cost of operating room: 25% of the cost of surgery, which is different according to the type of insurance coverage.

- ✓ Paraclinical costs: include pharmacy, radiology and laboratory costs, which vary according to the type of service provided.
- Consumption costs: All hospital costs are based on the tariff approved by the Ministry of Health, Treatment and Medical Education, which is the same in all private hospitals of the first level.
